Please Note:

- 1. The TPVRC has standardized the following shooting categories for service matches unless advised.
 - a. As Issued Service Rifle
 - b. Modified Service Rifle
 - c. Match Iron Rifle
 - d. Match Optic Rifle
 - e. 223 rifle (70gn projectiles and 6 x power scope)
 - f. Masters
 - g. Juniors

- Standard Service Matches (SSM) Matches are shot on service targets at 100, 200 and 300m. No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, etc.) can be used. Range positions: 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing)
- 3. **F Class, Sporter/Hunter** Matches are shot prone from the mound using front and rear rests.
 - a. Standard Class- .308 or .223 calibers only
 - (A and B graded by club captain).
 - b. Open Class- Any other caliber up to 8mm
 - c. Sporter/Hunter Any commercially available rifle, check <u>SSR's</u> for specific rules.
- Field Class
 - Any scoped field rifle can be shot in this class at ranges/ positions, 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing). No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, ect.) can be used.

 Note: A bench class is now available as field class event for shooters who are over 65 or have a medical disability. For more information on field class <u>click here</u>

REMINDER TO CLUB MEMBERS

- Under the new firearms regulations all club members are required to attend a minimum of 4 shoots per year to maintain their shooters licence.
