## Shooting Program - Jan 2021 to Dec 2021

- Please note that due to safety or other circumstances shoots may need to be cancelled, changed or moved to another date. Any changes to the program will be communicated by email distribution (*only*) as soon as changes have been determined. So that you are not disadvantaged can you please ensure:
  - The club has your current email address.**
  - That you check your email before coming to the range**
- Empty chamber indicators (ECI's) are available from the club and are the preferred option for indicating a firearm is safe when not on the firing line.

Date	Match
16 - Jan	600metre International Service and F class deliberate. Deliberate, 2 x 10 shot strings on ten ring targets.
23 - Jan	<b>300metre Night shoot</b> on reduced targets – entry fee \$15, commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ included. 4 targets x 5 shots per target plus sighters, keep targets, (Club members only). \$15 entry fee.  <b>Note:</b> A swap meet will be available for members to swap/sell unwanted items prior to this shoot. Due to legislation no primers, powder, loaded ammo or firearms.
30 - Jan	<b>100metre Rimfire Fly</b> , from the benches - 2 stages – 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12minutes per stage, warning at 10minutes. 12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.
6 - Feb	500m. F class shoot from the mound on 10 ring targets 2 x deliberate 10 shot strings, front and rear rests.
13 - Feb	<b>Pairs day</b> – 500metre centrefire and 50metre rimfire both shot from the 500metre bench. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
20 - Feb	200metre NRA field class practice – No specialized shooting
27- Feb	<b>Prize shoot, financial Club members only.</b> As issued service rifle, service optic, match iron and match optic classes. Program will include a 300metre application and snap (on a type B target) to be shot unsupported, <b>as issued and optic</b> (set to 6 power) <b>service rifle</b> shooters no specialised coats or gloves. Every shooter gets a pick of the prize table. 12.00pm start. \$25.00 entry fee. Every financial member welcome, so come along and have a fun shoot with all the club's members. <b>Annual General Meeting to be held after this shoot</b>
6 – Mar	<b>300metre Night shoot</b> on reduced targets – entry fee \$15, commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ included. 4 targets x 5 shots per target plus sighters, keep targets, (Club members only).
13 - Mar	200metre and 100 metre NRA field class practice. Full course at each range. – No specialised shooting aids.
20 - Mar	300metre standard service and match (SSM) iron/optical – application, rapid and snap, no specialised shooting aids
27 - Mar	<b>Pairs day</b> – 500metre centrefire and 50metre rimfire both shot from the 500metre bench. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10 shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
3 – Apr	300metre ASR service, match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap.

Date	Match
10 - Apr	300m Field class and service practice and sighting in day. The portable frames will be set up at 50metres for 22 rimfire shooting. Both from the 300metre mound. Professional coaching may be available.
17 - Apr	300metre zero and practice day for Anzac shoot.
24 - Apr	<p><b>Anzac Memorial shoot</b> – Including Harry Hall and Wal Cameron Memorial Trophies. 300metres x 1 application, 1 snap and 1 double snap on a type B target. All matches to be shot off front sand bags only, no specialised coats or gloves. <b>Classes:</b> 303 any iron sight, 303 optic class (set to 6 power) and any other service rifle from WW1 or 2 eras. Sign on from 12:30am - prizes for first 3 shooters in each class, entry fee \$20.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> At the conclusion of the Anzac matches the Long Tan shoot will be conducted using 223 and 308 rifles. Final format to be advised prior to the shoot.</p>
1 - May	600metre International Service and F class deliberate. Deliberate 2 x 10 strings – (front and back rests for F class only).
8 - May	<b>Working Bee 9:30am</b> – 200metre NRA - field class match – No specialized shooting aids.
15 - May	200metre and 100 metre NRA field class practice. 2 x 10 shots at each range ** see note
22 - May	<b>Working Bee 9:30am</b> - 300metre NRA field class practice - No specialized shooting aids.
29/30 – May	<b>NRA Field class invitation match</b> – (300,200,100metre) - graded. As per NRAA field class rules. 66 rounds in total (Saturday). Sunday – SSM 300metre application, rapid, single snap and double snap (48 rounds), as issued, match iron and match optic classes – no specialised shooting aids.
5 - Jun	500 metre F class. Front and rear rests. 10 shots plus sighters at each range.
12 - Jun	<b>100metre Rimfire Fly</b> , from the benches - 2 stages – 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12minutes per stage, warning at 10minutes. 12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.
19 - Jun	300metre standard service and match (SSM) iron/optical – application, rapid and snap, no specialised aids. ** see note
26 - Jun	600metre International Service and F class standard and open. x 2 details.
3 – Jul	<b>Pairs day</b> – 500metre centrefire and 50metre rimfire both shot from the 500metre bench. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
10 - Jul	300metre NRA field class format practice shoot, 2 sighters x 20 to scores
17 - Jul	200metre service and match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap – ASR
24 - Jul	<b>The Pursehouse Rural</b> – 600metre F class shoot. F Open and F Standard classes, 3 details – 2 x sighters and 10 to score. 10:00am start. More details to be provided prior to the date.
31 - Jul	<b>Service Shoot</b> – 300metre service shoot, open to all service rifles and modified service rifles (223). Three classes – optic service rifle (set to 6 power), modified service and any iron sight service rifle. 1 x application and 1 x double snap on fig 11 targets to be shot off sand bags, no rear rests.
7 - Aug	<b>500metre Fly, Club Championships</b> - 3 stages, 3 sighters, 5 for a group in each stage. 12:00noon start, \$15 entry fee.
14 - Aug	200metre Standard service (SSM), deliberate rapid and snap, no specialised aids, iron and optic.
21 - Aug	<p><b>100metre Rimfire Fly</b>, from the benches - 2 stages – 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12minutes per stage, warning at 10minutes. 12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.</p> <p><b>500metre Fly, Club Championships</b> - 3 stages, 3 sighters, 5 for a group in each stage. 12:00noon start, \$15 entry fee.</p>
28 - Aug	300metre International Service, deliberate, rapid.
4 – Sep	<b>Pairs day</b> – 500metre centrefire and 50metre rimfire both shot from the 500metre bench. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
11 - Sep	300metre service and match (SSM) iron/optical – application, rapid and snap.
18 - Sep	600metre International Service and F class deliberate. Del. X 2.

Date	Match
25 - Sep	<b>Working bee for annual Service shoot (9am)</b> – 300metre service and match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap.
2 - Oct	200metre NRA Field shoot – no specialised aids.
9 - Oct	<b>Working Bee for annual Service shoot (9am)</b> – 100metre - 200metre NRA field class practice day.
16/17 - Oct	<b>Annual Service rifle championships and prize table.</b> <u>Saturday</u> – NRA Field class (300,200,100metre) – graded, as per NRAA field class rules. 66 rounds in total. Medals awarded for first 3 places in each grade. <u>Sunday</u> – AMC 300metre application, rapid and snap (on 4 x 4). 200metre rapid (fig 11 targets), single snap (fig 12 targets) followed by presentation (3 classes – as issued, service optic, match iron and optical). Medals and patches awarded plus every shooter gets a pick of the table based on aggregate scores for the Sunday.  <b>Note:</b> All classes to shoot unsupported, service optic 4xpower, match optic 6xpower.
23 - Oct	200metre Service - Double Snap on Fig 12 & 14 targets x 2 detail, bipods only, no back rests.
30 - Oct	300metre NRA Field shoot – no specialised aids.
6 - Nov	200metre and 100 metre NRA field class practice. 2 x 10 at each range ** <b>see note</b>
13 - Nov	300metre service and match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap, ASR format.
20 - Nov	300metre F class shoot on reduced targets.
27 - Nov	<b>Prize shoot, financial Club members only.</b> 600metre International Service and F class deliberate. Del. X 2, F class standard and open, match rifle classes <u>ONLY</u> . Every shooter gets a pick of the prize table. 12.30pm start. \$25.00 entry fee. Every financial member welcome, so come along and have a fun shoot and test your skill at 600metres.
4 - Dec	<b>Service Shoot</b> – 300metre service shoot, open to all service rifles and modified service rifles (223). Three classes – optic service rifle (set to 6 power), modified service and any iron sight service rifle. 1 x application and 1 x double snap on fig 11 targets to be shot off sand bags, no rear rests.
11 - Dec	<b>300metre Night shoot</b> on reduced targets – commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ (Club members only). \$15 entry fee.
18 - Dec	<b>22 Rimfire Metallic Silhouette</b> , from the benches - 2 stages – 3 ranges per stage (30, 60 & 90 metres), 5 sighters on paper targets at 60 metres for the first stage only. Harris style bipods as a front rest, no rear bags. 12:00noon start, \$5 entry fee.
19 - Dec	Christmas party, Calala Inn: 2 – 2:30pm – <b>Final details to be advised.</b>

**Please Note:**

1. The club has adopted the following shooting categories.
  - a. Standard service category
  - b. Match iron category
  - c. Match optic category
2. **The Australian Service Rifle (ASR)** matches are shot on military figure targets at 100, 200 and 300 metres. Range positions: 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing)
3. **The Standard Service Matches (SSM)** matches are shot on military figure targets at 100, 200 and 300 metres. No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, ect.) can be used. Range positions: 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing)
4. **F Class** – The match is shot prone from the mound using front and rear rests
  - a. Standard – 308 or 223 calibers
  - b. Open – any caliber up to 8mm
5. **Field Class** – Any scoped field rifle can be shot in this class at ranges 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing). No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, ect.) can be used.

## **REMINDER TO CLUB MEMBERS**

1. Under the new firearms regulations all club members are required to attend a minimum of **4** shoots per year to maintain their shooters licence. The club is required to submit an annual return to the Firearms Registry of those shooters who ***have not*** complied with these regulations. This attendance period ends on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021
2. **Members completing shoots at other ranges should notify the secretary so that these can be recorded as range attendances.** Members should note that 4 attendances have to be recorded against the Tamworth Peel Valley Rifle Club approval number.
3. Annual Tamworth and Peel Valley Club membership fees are due by the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 A schedule of fees and reminder will be emailed to all members.
