1. Please note that due to safety or other circumstances shoots may need to be cancelled, changed or moved to another date. Any changes to the program will be communicated by email distribution (*only*) as soon as changes have been determined. So that you are not disadvantaged can you please ensure:
 - I. **The club has your current email address.**
 - II. **That you check your email before coming to the range**
2. Empty chamber indicators (ECI's) are available from the club and are the preferred option for indicating a firearm is safe when not on the firing line.

15 - Jan	600m- F Class and F Target Rifle (unsupported sling, coat, glove). Deliberate, 2 x 10-shot strings on MR-1 target- ** see note 3 & 5
22 - Jan	300m Night Shoot- TPVRC Night Shoot targets. Commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ included. 4 targets x 5 shots per target plus sighters, keep targets, (Club members only). \$15 entry fee.
29 - Jan	100m Rimfire Fly- from the benches - 2 stages – 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12 minutes per stage. 12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.
5 - Feb	500m F Class .223 rifles only- From the mound deliberate, 2 x 10 shot strings on SR-3 target- ** see note 3
12 - Feb	Pairs day- 500m centrefire and 50m Rimfire BR, both shot from the 500m benches- 1 stage- 1 target, 15 shots, unlimited sighters, Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10-shot centrefire and rimfire match (TPVRC target). 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
19 - Feb	200m- NRA Field Class practice and Service Rifle practice – No specialized shooting aids.
26- Feb	300m Service Prize Shoot, Financial Club Members Only- Program will include a 300m application and snap (type B target) to be shot unsupported. Classes ** see note 1 As Issued and optic service rifle (set to 6 power) no specialised coats or gloves. Every shooter gets a pick of the prize table.12.00pm start. \$25.00 entry fee. Every financial member welcome, so come along and have a fun shoot with all the club's members. Annual General Meeting to be held after this shoot
5 – Mar	300m Night Shoot- TPVRC Night Shoot Targets. Commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ included. 4 targets x 5 shots per target plus sighters, keep targets, (Club members only). \$15 entry fee. (There will be a Field Class sighting in option in the afternoon for people travelling to Coffs Harbour for 2021 State Champs).
12 - Mar	200m and 100m Service Practice.
19 - Mar	Working Bee 9:30am- 300m Service Practice.
26/27 - Mar	TAM22 Service Match- NOTE: Refer to flyer for more specific details.
2 – Apr	Pairs Day- 500m centrefire and 100m rimfire both shot from the 500m benches. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10-shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
9 - Apr	300m Field Class and Service Practice and sighting in day- The portable frames will be set up at 50metres for 22 rimfire shooting. Both shot from the 300m mound.
16 - Apr	Working Bee 9:30am- 300m- Zero and practice day for Anzac Memorial Matches.

23 - Apr	<p>Anzac Memorial Matches – Including the Harry Hall and Wal Cameron Memorial Trophies. 300m x 1 application, 1 snap and 1 double snap on a type B target. Optional front sandbags service rifles only, no specialised coats or gloves. Classes: 303 As Issued, 303 optic / range sight class (set to 6 power) and any other service rifle from WW1 or 2 eras. Sign on from 12:30am - prizes for first 3 shooters in each class, entry fee \$20. Financial members only.</p> <p>Note: At the conclusion of the Anzac matches the Long Tan shoot will be conducted using 223 and 308 rifles. Final format to be advised prior to the shoot.</p>

Deliberate 2 x 10-shot strings on MR-1 Target.</p>
4 - Jun	500m F Class .223 rifles only- From the mound deliberate, 2 x 10 shot strings on SR-3 target- ** see note 3
11 - Jun	50m Rimfire BR- (TPVRC targets) from the benches. 2 stages- 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, with a time limit of 17minutes per stage.12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.
18 - Jun	300m- Standard Service Match (SSM) iron/optical- application, rapid and snap, no specialised aids- ** see note 2
25 - Jun	200m- Service and match iron/optical- application, rapid and snap.
2 – Jul	Pairs Day- 500m centrefire and 100m rimfire, both shot from 500m benches. Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10-shot centrefire and rimfire match. 12:00pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.
9 - Jul	300m- NRA Field Class course- ** see note 4
16 - Jul	600m- F Class and F Target Rifle (unsupported sling, coat, glove). Deliberate 2 x 10-shot strings on MR-1 target- ** see note 3 & 5
23 - Jul	The TPVRC F Class Championships- 600metre F Class shoot. F Open and F Standard classes, 3 details – 2 x sighters and 10 to score.10:00am start. More details to be provided prior to the date.
30 - Jul	300m Service Shoot- Open to all service rifles and modified service rifles (223). Three classes- optic service rifle (set to 6 power), modified service and any iron sight service rifle. 1 x application and 1 x double snap on fig 11 targets to be shot off sandbags, no rear rests.
6 - Aug	500m Fly Club Championships - 3 stages, 3 sighters, 5 for a group in each stage. 12:00noon start, \$15 entry fee.
13 - Aug	200m- Standard Service Match (SSM) iron/optical- application, rapid and snap, no specialized aids- ** see note 2
20 - Aug	100m Rimfire Fly- from the benches. 2 stages- 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12 minutes per stage.12:00noon start, \$10 entry fee.
27 - Aug	300m- Standard Service Match (SSM) iron/optical- application, rapid and snap, no specialized aids- ** see note 2
3 – Sep	Pairs Day- 500m centrefire and 50m Rimfire BR, both shot from the 500m benches- 1 stage- 1 target, 15 shots, unlimited sighters, Shooters will shoot in pairs, with each competitor shooting a 10-shot centrefire and rimfire match (TPVRC target). 12:30pm start. Entry fee \$10 a pair.

10 - Sep	300m- Standard Service Match (SSM) iron/optical – application, rapid and snap, no specialized aids- ** see note 2
17 - Sep	600m- F Class and F Target Rifle (unsupported sling, coat, glove) Deliberate 2 x 10-shot strings on MR-1 target- ** see note 3 & 5
24 - Sep	Working Bee 9:30am - 300m- Service and match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap.
1 - Oct	300m- F Class practice.
8 - Oct	Working Bee 9:30am -200m Service and match iron/optical – application, rapid and snap.
15/16 - Oct	Annual Service Rifle & F Class Championships and Prize Table. <u>Saturday</u> – F Class, 300m, 223 rifles <u>ONLY</u> . 2 x details with a Harris Bipod as a front rest and rear bag. Followed by 600m- 2 x details- Classes- F Open and F Standard (A & B grade). <u>Sunday</u> – Service Match- 300m application, rapid and snap (on Type B). 200m rapid (fig 11), single snap (fig 12). Classes ** see note 1 . Medals awarded plus every shooter gets a pick of the table based on aggregate scores for the Sunday. Shoot open to all financial members and invited guests.
22 - Oct	300m- Service and Field- Double Snap on Fig 12 & 14 targets x 2 detail, bipods only, no back rests.
29 - Oct	300m- NRA Field Class course- ** see note 4.
5 - Nov	200m and 100m- NRA Field Class course. 2 x 20 at each range- ** see note 4.
12 - Nov	300m- Service and match iron/optical- application, rapid and snap.
19 - Nov	300m- Daylight shoot on night shoot targets.
26 - Nov	Prize Shoot- Financial Club Members Only- 600m F Class and F Target Rifle (unsupported sling, coat, glove). Deliberate 2 x 10-shot strings on MR-1 target. Every shooter gets a pick of the prize table. 12.00pm start. \$25.00 entry fee. Every financial member welcome, so come along and have a fun shoot and test your skill at 600m- ** see note 3 & 5
3 - Dec	300m Service Shoot- Open to all service rifles and modified service rifles (223). Three classes – optic service rifle (set to 6 power), modified service and any iron sight service rifle. 1 x application and 1 x double snap on fig 11 targets to be shot off sandbags, no rear rests.
10 - Dec	300m Night Shoot- TPVRC Night Shoot targets. TPVRC Night Shoot targets. Commencing 6:00pm with a BBQ included. 4 targets x 5 shots per target plus sighters, keep targets, (Club members only). \$15 entry fee.
17 - Dec	22 Rimfire Metallic Silhouette- from the benches- 2 stages- 3 ranges per stage (30, 60 & 90 metres), 5 sighters on paper targets at 60 metres for the first stage only. Harris style bipods as a front rest, no rear bags. 12:00noon start, \$5 entry fee.
18 - Dec	Christmas party – Final details to be advised.

Please Note:

1. The TPVRC has standardized the following shooting categories for service matches unless advised.
 - a. As Issued Service Rifle
 - b. Modified Service Rifle
 - c. Match Iron Rifle
 - d. Match Optic Rifle
 - e. Masters
 - f. Juniors

2. **Standard Service Matches (SSM)-** Matches are shot on service targets at 100, 200 and 300m. No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, etc.) can be used. Range positions: 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing)

3. **F Class-** Matches are shot prone from the mound using front and rear rests. Super center in target.
 - a. Standard Class- .308 or .223 calibers only
(A and B graded by club captain).
 - b. Open Class- Any other caliber up to 8mm

4. **Field Class-** Any scoped field rifle can be shot in this class at ranges/ positions, 300m (prone), 200m (seated) and 100m (standing). No specialized shooting aids (coats, gloves, ect.) can be used.
Note: A bench class is now available as field class event for shooters who are over 65 or have a medical disability. For more information on field class [click here](#)
5. **F Target Rifle-** Matches are shot from the mound in the prone position with the support of a sling only. Match equipment such as coat, glove and mat can be used. Scored with no super center.

REMINDER TO CLUB MEMBERS

1. Under the new firearms regulations all club members are required to attend a minimum of **4** shoots per year to maintain their shooters licence. The club is required to submit an annual return to the Firearms Registry of those shooters who **have not** complied with these regulations. This attendance period ends on the 30th June 2022
2. **Members completing shoots at other ranges should notify the secretary so that these can be recorded as range attendances.** Members should note that 4 attendances have to be recorded against the Tamworth Peel Valley Rifle Club approval number.
